

GENERAL

General Guidelines for Container Use:

1. The weight must not exceed 200 lbs.
2. All garbage must be bagged inside the black cart.
3. Recycling must be placed loose into the blue cart (the exception being shredded paper which must be placed in a clear plastic garbage bag (not a shopping bag)).
4. Do not remove the cart from its assigned address.
5. Inform the Town Office of any damage, vandalism or theft of any cart.

Do's and Don'ts of Cart Use:

DO:

1. Place the cart according to the diagrams in this pamphlet.
2. Pull the cart—it is easier than pushing
3. Keep the lid closed
4. Place all trash in the cart “bagged”

DON'T:

1. Put hot ashes, oil or contaminants in the cart
2. Overfill the cart
3. Pack trash in too tightly
4. Put construction debris in the cart
5. Remove the cart from your residence
6. Paint or write on the cart.

BIN PLACEMENT



PARK IT

- Park the cart for pickup Monday night.
- When there is a snow bank built up along the curb, make sure the container is out further than the snow as illustrated in drawing #2

POINT IT

- Point lid arrows towards the street
- Close lid

SPACE IT

- Ensure cart is 1 metre (3 feet) clear of all obstacles (including other carts) and not blocking traffic (#3/#4)

GARBAGE

Each residence is supplied with a black rollaway cart. Multi-unit residences are supplied with stationary or commercial containers for use by residents.

Garbage pickup will be every other Tuesday, alternating with Recycling pickup. Carts must be placed on the street in front of your residence Monday night and removed within 24 hours after pickup.

WHAT CAN I PLACE IN MY BLACK CART?

Most household garbage can be placed in your black cart. All garbage must be bagged before being placed in the cart, the lid must be able to close, and the weight of the full bin cannot exceed 200 pounds.

WHAT CAN'T I PLACE IN MY CART?

The following **CANNOT** be placed in the black carts:

- Ashes
- Tires
- Oil filters
- No concrete or large metal objects
- Hazardous chemicals such as gas, oil, paint
- Anything recyclable (unless it is soiled)
- White waste (fridges, stoves, etc.)
- Grass/dirt/branches/leaves/garden waste

ELECTRONICS

Electronics are accepted for Recycling at the Churchbridge Transfer Site at no charge under the Saskatchewan EPRA Program. Accepted electronics include TV's, monitors, corded/cordless phones, VCRs, DVD/CD players, computers, video game systems, photocopiers and more. A few items that are NOT accepted includes back up camera systems, CB radios, discs, calculators, or satellite dishes. RECYCLING

Each residence is supplied with a blue rollaway cart. Multi-unit residences are supplied with stationary containers for use by residents.

Recycling pickup will be every other Tuesday, alternating with Garbage pickup. Carts must be placed on the street in front of your residence Monday morning and removed within 24 hours after pickup.

WHAT CAN I PLACE IN MY BLUE CART?

The following can be placed in the blue carts:

- Cardboard, boxboard, office paper, newsprint, junk mail, magazines and catalogues
- Shredded paper (Paper must NOT be loose. Must be in a clear plastic garbage bag, NOT a shopping bag)
- Plastic containers, milk cartons and plastic milk jugs, plastics number 1 through 7 (NO food containers labeled #1)(NO oil containers or chemical jugs, NO plastic wrap or bags)
- Tin and aluminum cans (must be clean without labels)

WHAT CAN'T I PLACE IN MY BLUE CART?

The following **CANNOT** be placed in the blue carts:

- Styrofoam
- Ceramics
- Light bulbs/Glass (any type)
- Soiled cardboard
- Hazardous chemical containers
- Scrap metal/Car parts
- Plastic toys/Household garbage
- Plastic wrap/Plastic bags (i.e. grocery/shopping bags)
- Food Containers labeled #1

TRANSFER SITE

HOURS

The transfer site provided by the Town/RM is for use by Town and RM residents only for the disposal of excess refuse materials and certain recycle materials. The hours of operation are as follows:

FALL HOURS (September 16th—April 30th)

Tuesday 1 p.m.—5 p.m.

Saturday 1 p.m.—5 p.m.

SUMMER HOURS (May 1st—September 15th)

Tuesday 1 p.m.—5 p.m.

Thursday 3 p.m.—8 p.m.

Saturday 12 p.m.—5 p.m.

FEES

Transfer site tickets are required to be purchased to take refuse out*. Town residents can purchase these at the Town Office during regular business hours. The Fees are as follows:

Household garbage:

- \$10/half ton load

Shingles:

- \$50/half ton load (1 ticket); \$100/dump trailer

load (2 tickets); \$150/grain truck load (3 tickets)

*Grass, compost, trees may be delivered for free to the transfer site.

CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS

A 6 yard bin can be arranged with the Town for the disposal of construction materials. The bins are rented on a Wednesday to Wednesday schedule. After contacting the Town Office to request rental, the bin will be dropped off at the requested address, and picked up the following Wednesday. If you require longer, or it fills early, please contact the office. The cost for rental is:

- \$100/per bin full +GST
