A BYLAW TO CONTROL THE DISPOSAL OF SCRAP TIRES


Whereas the Saskatchewan Scrap Tire Corporation has implemented a program in Saskatchewan to recycle scrap tires, therefore,


The Council of the Town of Churchbridge, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. It is unlawful to deposit scrap tires in the municipal owned landfill on Portion of South east Section of 29 Township 22 Range 32 West of Prime Meridian.
2. It is unlawful to deposit scrap tires on any other municipal property unless specifically designated as a tire marshalling yard.
3. A person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction shall be liable to a fine of not less than Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars.
