
TOWN OF CHURCHBRIDGE

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS.

The Council of the Town of Churchbridge, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be referred to as the " General Penalty Bylaw " of the municipality.
2. Section 3 applies only to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other fine is provided.
3. Subject to the provisions of section 2, any individual found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by the authority of The Urban Municipality Act, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$2,000.00 and costs for every offence.
4. Subject to the provisions of section 2, any corporation found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority of the Urban Municipality Act, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 and costs for every offence.
5. Bylaw No. 3 - 79 passed August 13, 1979 is hereby repealed.
