

BYLAW NO. 2 - 95

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CHURCHBRIDGE FOR THE PROHIBITION OF THE USE OF FIREARMS AND FIREWORKS IN THE TOWN.

THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CHURCHBRIDGE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

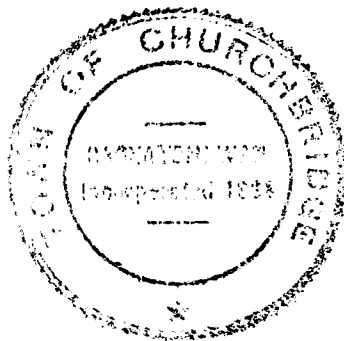
1. In this bylaw the word "firearms" shall be deemed to include any type or calibre of firearm or any type of air pistol, gas operated pistol, bow and arrow set or homemade propellant device.
2. With the exception of #4 article herein, no person shall, within Town limits, discharge any type or calibre of firearm without first obtaining a permit from the Town office or the Churchbridge Police Department Service. Permits may be obtained only by persons who have attained the age of sixteen (16) years.
3. No person under the age of twelve (12) years shall, within the limits of the Town, carry or be in possession of any type of firearm.
4. The use of an air or gas operated gun or pistol, or bow and arrow set shall be allowed as target practise in the dwelling structure of a private residence, provided a safe and adequate facility has been constructed and the practise is conducted in the presence of a responsible adult, with parental or legal guardian consent.
5. No person shall ignite or discharge any fireworks of any type or size within the limits of the Town without first obtaining a special permit to do so from the Town Offices. Said permit shall be subject to approval by a designated representative of the Churchbridge & District Volunteer Fire Brigade.
6. Any person found guilty of, or responsible for, an infraction of the provisions of this Bylaw, shall be held liable to the penalties imposed by the General Penalty Bylaw No. 3-79 of the Town of Churchbridge. 2-88
7. Bylaw No. 10-65 is hereby recinded.
