ATV Awareness

Just a friendly reminder that driving an ATV requires the individual to be at least 16 years of age, have a valid driver’s license on them or be able to produce it within 48 hours. As stated by the *All Terrain Vehicles Act*, an ATV has to be used “for the purpose of leaving or entering the Town of Churchbridge at its shortest distance.” This does not include leisurely adventures but rather to get from one destination to another.

- Maintain a safe distance behind any other vehicle
- Signalling intentions are to turn abruptly by using light or hand signals
- On being signaled by a peace officer, stop the all terrain vehicle
- Wear a helmet and protection for the eyes as prescribed

Be safe and enjoy the summer!



Furthermore, under section 17 and 18 of the Act, the following are rules for the safe operation of an all terrain vehicle:

- When approaching an oncoming vehicle, pass the vehicle to the right
- Yield the right of way to vehicles approaching from his left
- When overtaking another vehicle, pass the vehicle on the left
- Yield the right of way to all pedestrians

Sewer Reminder

Just a friendly reminder that certain items should NOT be flushed down the toilet, these include: paper towels, cleaning wipes, diapers, nursing pads, baby wipes, facial tissues, cat litter, condoms, feminine hygiene products, dental floss, hair, and grease.

The label may say “flushable”, but these disposable products are clogging the sewer pipes and damaging the pumps and equipment. In the past, there was a shop towel clogging the sewer system and it costed the town \$1500.00 to unplug. This incident costs the town residents money and could potentially damage homes.

Animal Reminder

Just a friendly reminder to keep your cat and/or dog within close proximity. There have been concerns about animals pooping on other people’s property. Any cat or dog is required to have a license within the town limits. These can be purchased from the Town Office. Please remember to have your pet on a leash if possible and if necessary, pick up after them.

The Animal Control Bylaw states that: “any animal defecating on other people’s property is an infraction of this bylaw and the owner or keeper of this animal, whether in his/her control or running at large shall cause such defecation to be removed immediately in a sanitary fashion or be subject to a fine.” More information can be found on the Town of Churchbridge website bylaw page, along with the fees associated for such infractions.

Spring Yard Cleaning Pick-up

The annual spring yard cleaning pick up day will be **Wednesday, May 23**.

Please have any yard waste placed in compostable bags (not plastic grocery or black/green garbage bags), boxes or cans (cans will be dumped and left for you) by your front yard area. Because not all back alleys in town are accessible, pick-up will continue to be from the front of the yard. Note: we still have some bags at the Town Office for use.

Swimming Lesson Registration

Four sessions of Lifesaving Society Swimming Lessons will be held this summer, with registration **May 24 from 4-6 p.m.** in the Community Centre. Levels for these sessions go from Pre-school through Swim Patrol (Rookie, Ranger, Star).

- ⇒ Session 1 - June 11-15 and June 18-22 (*two-week, one lesson per day, after school*)
- ⇒ Session 2 - July 9-13 (*one week, two lessons per day*)
- ⇒ Session 3 - July 23-27 (*one week, two lessons per day*)
- ⇒ Session 4 - Aug. 13-17 (*one week, two lessons per day*)

Child must be 4-years-old by the session start date.
