RE: Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory – Town of Churchbridge (Portion Only)

The Water Security Agency (WSA), has advised that the Town of Churchbridge issue a **“Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory”** to the following areas (240-249 1st Ave & 117-119 Cedar Crescent) within the Town of Churchbridge.

Despite the good efforts of the operator, a precautionary drinking water advisory (PDWA) is issued in order to accommodate the tie-in of a new water main in which a section of the Town’s distribution system will be shut down and depressurized. Therefore, the WSA is issuing a “Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory” (PDWA) for the Town’s potable water system.

This advisory goes in effect as of 10:00 am Wednesday October 11, 2017 for the Town of Churchbridge and will be in effect until further notice. Therefore, I ask that the Town of Churchbridge’s administration notify all users of the drinking water distribution system that they boil the water used for drinking purposes for at least one minute prior to use. Bottled water can be a safe alternative.

This **“Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory”** shall remain in effect until the water is bacteriologically free and safe for consumption. Should you have any questions or concerns, please contact me at (306) 728-7492.
