### VOTING

To vote in the town election you must:

- be a Canadian citizen;
- be at least 18 years of age and one of the following;
  - have lived in Saskatchewan for at least six consecutive months immediately before election day and;
  - lived in the municipality (or on land now in the municipality) for at least three consecutive months immediately before election day; or
  - be the owner of assessable land situated in the municipality (or land now situated in the municipality) for at

least three consecutive months immediately before election day.

**Voters must bring with them valid identification or they will not be permitted to**

**vote.** Photo ID (i.e. drivers license, ID card issued by SGI) is your best option. Accepted photo ID is government-issued, valid and has your photo, name and address.

Canadian passports are not acceptable as they do not display your address. However, if paired with another document that does have this information it could be accepted (i.e. bank statement or recent utility bill (within 6 months of election)).

**Did you know?** Even though 6 councillor positions are held within the Town, a voter does not have to vote for 6 candidates. For example, if 8 residents run for Council, a voter may choose to only vote for 4 out of the 8 candidates. The 6 candidates with the highest amount of votes after all ballots are counted would then be elected.

# **REMINDERS**

## **LICENSING**

1) All cats or dogs are required to have a license within Town limits. These can be purchased from the Town Office. Dog and Cat Licenses are as follows:

Cat- \$10-\$25 each

Dog- \$10-\$25 each

Please bring in a copy of proof of rabies vaccination from your veterinarian.



2) Any business or individual who conducts business within Town limits is required to purchase a Business License. Licenses are valid for one calendar year. The fees range from \$50 to \$100, depending if your business employs others. Once the fee has been paid, your business will be listed on the Town Website.

## **CAMPER STORAGE**

Camper storage is offered at the Churchbridge campground through the winter months. If you are interested in storing your camper at the campground please contact the Town Office. We require a copy of the policy on the camper, as well as a signed waiver. Fees are \$75 for annual storage, or \$50 for the winter season.

## **ATV SNOWMOBILE BYLAW**

A reminder that per our ATV Bylaw (Bylaw 2015-015) and Snowmobile Bylaw (Bylaw 2015-016) a person is authorized to operate an ATV or snowmobile on the travelled portion of any municipal lane or street **ONLY** for the purpose of leaving or entering the town at its shortest distance.

## **PARKING PROTOCOL**

As per the Operation of Vehicles and Parking Bylaw 2012-009, a vehicle should be parked off the pavement to ensure they are not impeding the road. Snow will be on the ground shortly and our streets are more accessible if vehicles are parked off the street.

## **ANIMALS**

Please pick up after your animals. It helps keep our town looking (and smelling) clean and tidy. Please utilize the garbage cans posted around town. Please keep cats from running at large by keeping them indoors or supervising them while outdoors.
