BENEVITY PROGRAM

Do you or someone you know work for Mosaic or Nutrien? Do you or they regularly volunteer in the community? If so, submit your volunteer hours through the Benevity! The Benevity program turns your volunteer hours into cash donated back into the community by Mosaic and Nutrien to a group of your choosing. Donations for the Churchbridge Cemetery, walking path, dog park, disc golf course, hanging flower baskets, Churchbridge fire department, Churchbridge Aquatic Centre, Sport court and the Kaminski Arena are all accepted at the Town Office and are eligible to receive a Charitable Receipt that can be used for tax purposes.

If there is a group you would like to allot your donation to that operates independent of the Town (i.e. the Curling Club or Golf Course), you may specify them in the notes section and we will ensure the funds are distributed to those groups. (Please note, we are not able to issue charitable receipts on behalf of groups that are independent of the town). Through the Benevity program a total of \$29,186.02 was donated to community groups in 2024; and we have already beat that in 2025 with \$32,274.93 having been donated back into the community!.

SNOW REMOVAL POLICY

Per the Winter Maintenance Policy, No. 24-001, snow removal shall be immediately following a snowfall and will be cleared in a designated sequence beginning with emergency routes. Slippery intersections will be sanded as needed after snow removal is complete. All efforts will be made to avoid leaving ridges; however, should there be a ridge it will be the responsibility of the property owner. Snow piles will be removed in as timely a fashion as is reasonable. Businesses will be responsible for clearing the snow from their own parking lots.

Property owners, or hired contractors on behalf of property owners, must pile the snow on their own property or haul it away. Snow may be hauled to the designated Town snow pile. Please do not pile snow in a way that blocks sight lines, and do not pile on culverts or in drainage ditches, on a neighbors property or undesignated town property.

The full Winter Maintenance Policy and Snow removal map can be viewed on the Town website or a copy requested at the Town Office. We appreciate everyone's cooperation going into the Winter season.
