# SNOW REMOVAL POLICY

Per the Winter Maintenance Policy, No. 24–001, snow removal shall being immediately following a snowfall and will be cleared in a designated sequence beginning with emergency routes. Slippery intersections will be sanded as needed after snow removal is complete. All efforts will be made to avoid leaving ridges; however, should there be a ridge it will be the responsibility of the property owner. Snow piles will be removed in as timely a fashion as is reasonable. Businesses will be responsible for clearing the snow from their own parking lots.

Property owners, or hired contractors on behalf of property owners, must pile the snow on their own property or haul it away. Snow may be hauled to the designated Town snow pile. Please do not pile snow in a way that blocks sight lines, and do not pile on culverts or in drainage ditches, on a neighbors property or undesignated town property.

The full Winter Maintenance Policy and Snow removal map can be viewed on the Town website or a copy requested at the Town Office. We appreicate everyone's cooperation going into the Winter season.
