SNOW REMOVAL POLICY

Per the Winter Maintenance Policy, No. 24-001, snow removal shall be immediately following a snowfall and will be cleared in a designated sequence beginning with emergency routes. Slippery intersections will be sanded as needed after snow removal is complete. All efforts will be made to avoid leaving ridges; however, should there be a ridge it will be the responsibility of the property owner. Snow piles will be removed in as timely a fashion as is reasonable. Businesses will be responsible for clearing the snow from their own parking lots.

Property owners, or hired contractors on behalf of property owners, must pile the snow on their own property or haul it away. Snow may be hauled to the designated Town snow pile. Please do not pile snow in a way that blocks sight lines, and do not pile on culverts or in drainage ditches, on a neighbors property or undesignated town property.

The full Winter Maintenance Policy and Snow removal map can be viewed on the Town website or a copy requested at the Town Office. We appreciate everyone's cooperation going into the Winter season.

2026 Business Licenses Due



Per the Business License Bylaw 2022-001, all vendors or contractors must possess a valid business license with the Town of Churchbridge.

Business Licenses can be purchased at the Administration office at an annual cost of \$50 and provide a business card or business information (contact, website, activities etc) at that time. License holders will be listed on the Town of Churchbridge website Business Directory.

Licenses expire on Dec 31st of each year and are due by January 31st of each year or upon start of any work within the Town of Churchbridge.

We ask that residents please check to make sure contractors hired have purchased a business license with the Town.

2026 Pet Licenses Due

Per the Animal Control Bylaw 2025-008, every person who owns or keeps a dog or cat shall obtain an animal license from Administration of the Town.



License fees are due by January 31st of each year or within 10 days of taking possession of the animal at an annual cost of \$10 per animal.



Licenses expire each year on December 31st regardless of license date. A Pet license information form must be filled out and date of most recent rabies vaccination and veterinarian provided.
