PAVING 2026

As part of the 2026 budget, paving will be completed on Vincent Avenue West from the west end of the street up to the Raikes St S/Hwy 80 intersection. A set amount of patching will be completed as well. The tender was awarded to G.R. Poier & Sons at the June 15th Council meeting.

DRIVEWAY APPROACH POLICY

The Town Office would like to remind residents of our Driveway Approach policy. Per policy the Town of Churchbridge has the management and control of every street, including the grade between a taxpayers property and street pavement or swale ditch. Pursuant to section 4(2) of the Municipalities Act, the town has the right to dig up and remove anything from the swale ditch if it causes drainage problems for the town. The replacement/repair cost will be at the taxpayer's own expense. The taxpayer must agree to and understand that if the grade runway (swale ditch) is not finished according to the Town of Churchbridge specifications and must be altered by the Town to repair drainage, they are liable for the replacement cost of any finish removed or repair needed of their swale ditch. Application forms for Finished Drive-way approaches are available at the Town Office or on the Town website.

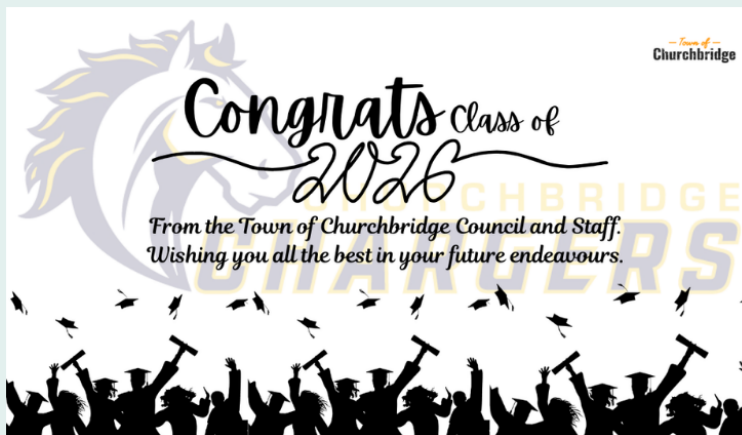

The annual fall yard waste pick-up dates are as follows:

- September 9th
- September 23rd
- October 14th

Please have any garden waste placed in paper bags and left curbside in front of your property. Branches will be accepted in bundles, but must be less than 4 feet in length.

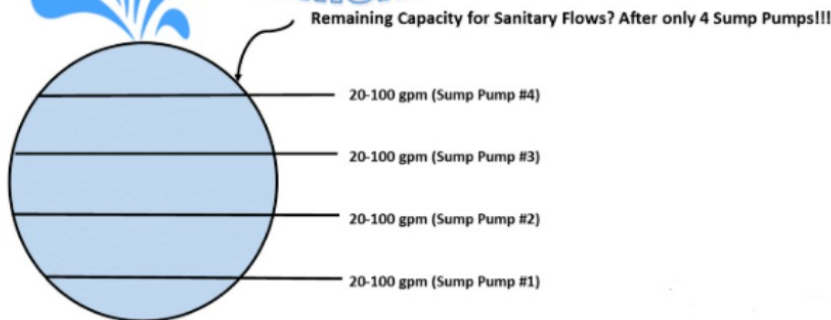
Staff begins pickup at 8 a.m. Please have bags curbside by this time or they may be missed and will need to put out for the next pickup or taken to the transfer site by the property owners. Yard waste can be taken to the Transfer site at no charge. NO PLASTIC BAGS

DID YOU KNOW?

DISCHARGE YOUR SUMP PUMP OUTSIDE-NOT DOWN THE SANITARY SEWER

- A few sump pumps discharging to the sanitary sewer can make a big difference on whether or not residents experience basement flooding
- A typical sump pump can pump 20-100 gallons per minute (gpm) depending on size and how high and far it has to pump
- A typical 8 inch sewer pipe has a design capacity of 350 gpm
- As few as FOUR pumps can take up the pipe capacity and cause a sewer backup in the neighborhood.
